## ACCESSIBILITY SERVICES CHECKLIST

- Gather supporting documentation (IEP, IPRC info, Psychological Assessment, medical form/note, copy of most recent Accommodation Letter/Plan from previous institution).
-  Contact Georgian College Student Success (1-877-722-1523) – make an appointment with an Accessibility Advisor (AA) to begin the process of registering with Accessibility Services and discuss possible academic accommodations with support from your documentation.
- Register for your courses – make an appointment with your AA. Please bring a list of all of your courses including professors' names and emails to appointment. You can find this: myInfo>MySchedule.
- Letter of Accommodation (LOA) will be sent to student and applicable professors. Note: this will be done each term.
-  Transition (Year 3) – discuss transition process with Georgian AA & meet with Lakehead AA at 705-330-4010 ext. 2103 or [oraccess@lakeheadu.ca](mailto:oraccess@lakeheadu.ca).
- Meet with AA & have LOA sent out (before the start of your Fall term).

## POINTS TO REMEMBER
